The Seniors Social Club wants to foster safe, fun and enjoyable social activities so we have developed this Code of Conduct that establishes a consistent standard for the behaviour of social club members.

It is the responsibility of each member to read and follow our Code of Conduct. If members do not follow this Code of Conduct, they will be removed from the Seniors Social Club.

- 1. Please respect the time, effort and activity cost of the hosts and organizers. If you need to cancel your RSVP, please do so in a timely manner so those on the waitlist can be contacted.
- 2. At social club events, please respect the comfort level of each member in sharing their physical space and personal information.
- 3. Let everyone be part of the discussion and group activity. Show self control by refraining from excessive talking or dominating the conversation.
- 4. Keep it light. Please refrain from groups discussions that may make people feel uncomfortable including topics on politics, religion, and other strong beliefs.
- 5. Refrain from words, actions and behaviour that demonstrate disrespect for other members, volunteers, event hosts or NexusBC staff. Unacceptable behaviour includes foul language, inappropriate jokes, racial, verbal and sexual harassment.
- 6. This social club is not a dating service. If a new friendship organically blooms into a romance, that's great, but if your primary intention is to look for potential dates, this is not the club for you.
- 7. Scent awareness. Please be aware of scent sensitivities and refrain from using strong fragrances. Good personal body hygiene is expected.
- 8. Anyone under the influence of alcohol or drugs at any social club activities will be asked to leave.
